Dear Members,

Per Capita is paid to the Presbytery de Cristo office each year to pay for their daily operations, Each church that is part of the Presbytery USA (PCUSA) pays a required amount for each member of the church. Paying Per Capita eases the burden of our church's working funds. In the last three years, our church membership has not collected 100% to pay our required Per Capita, so the church fund has had to make up the difference of the amount owed.

For our church to pay the difference, it takes money away from other needs. Those who can afford to pay the per capita, please pay \$41.50 per member and if you would like to contribute to the per capita fund so we don't have to take the difference from our general fund, it is greatly appreciated.



SESSION at THE HOLY WAY Presbyterian Church

G-2.0301 Ruling Elder Defined -As there were in Old Testament times elders for the government of the people, so the New Testament church provided persons with particular gifts to share in discernment of God's Spirit and governance of God's people. Accordingly, congregations should elect persons of wisdom and maturity of faith, having demonstrated skills in leadership and being compassionate in spirit. Ruling elders are so named not because they "lord it over" the congregation (Matt. 20:25), but because they are chosen by the congregation to discern and measure its fidelity to the Word of God, and to strengthen and nurture its faith and life.

Ruling elders, together with ministers of the Word and Sacrament (Pastor), exercise leadership, government, spiritual discernment, and discipline and have responsibilities for the life of a congregation as well as the whole church, including ecumenical relationships. When elected by the congregation, they shall serve faithfully as members of the session. When elected as commissioners to higher councils, ruling elders participate and vote with the same authority as ministers of the Word and Sacrament, and they are eligible for any office.
